To be eligible for the scholarship, you must have a minimum SAT composite score of 1000 (on the Math and Reading/Writing portions combined), and/or an ACT composite score of 21. All SAT and/or ACT scores must be from the same test date.

Deadline for the SUBMISSION/RECEIPT of your application is 4:00 PM, on February 16th (If this date falls on a weekend, the application should be received no later than 4:00 PM of the preceding Friday) of the student's senior year.
